### Graduate academic credit at Cemanahuac



Cemanahuac can offer graduate credit for Spanish language and cultural study, in cooperation with Ashland University (Ohio) and instructor Tonya Tiggett of Speak Our Language. Three hours of graduate credit are available for two weeks of study, and the full program includes registration, 45 hours of language instruction, housing with a Mexican family (double room), textbook, two all-day field study trips, one half-day trip, cultural studies classes, a certificate of completion and transcript, and academic costs for three hours of credit, for a total fee in 2010 of \$1810.00.

In addition to attendance at language classes and field study trips, requirements include a journal and a written project on some area of cultural or language studies which will be helpful to the individual student's professional life.

Students can come at any time of the year, and single rooms are available at a small additional fee. It is also possible to attend Cemanahuac for one week for 1 hour of graduate credit.

The credit is offered through the Professional Development program in the College of Education, and thus does not have a minimum language requirement for registration. Teachers and others with an undergraduate degree in any field can apply.

As with any academic credit, those planning to use this credit toward a graduate degree should discuss this educational opportunity with a professor in their own universities.
